

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Kindly read the information below before you complete an application online

- 1. One applicant should submit only one application.
- 2. For one to apply online, s/he should have an active e-mail account.
- 3. Prospective applicants should read the entry requirements carefully and ensure that they apply for programmes for which they meet the general and specific entry requirements including the Application Cut Off points. Meeting the minimum entry requirements does not guarantee admission as admission is based on academic merit and availability of space.
- 4. A list of undergraduate programmes offered by the University of Botswana and the Guide on Application Cut-off points are part of the Application Package. All the programmes of study are accredited and/or registered on the National Credit and Qualification Framework (NCQF) with the Botswana Qualifications Authority (BQA). Applicants are therefore advised to select programmes carefully taking into account the strength of their grades and the 2024 Guide on Application Cut-off points. The 2024 Guide on Application Cut-Off Points are a Guide only and should therefore not be treated as the Final Admission Cut-Off Points.
- 5. In completing the application, prospective

- applicants should enter their study choices in order of preference, and then select the programme offer mode such as Full-time, Part-time or Distance Learning, plus the Campus where each of the two programmes is offered.
- 6. Prospective applicants are required to pay an APPLICATION FEE, WHICH IS NON REFUNDABLE, online through the link https://www.ub.bw/ubpayments or into the University of Botswana (UB) bank accounts listed under Financial Procedures, which is part of the Application Package. Prospective applicants may ONLY PAY the Application Fee if they meet all the set requirements as the APPLICATION FEE IS NON REFUNDABLE.
- 7. The receipt for the Application Fee payment should be scanned in readiness for uploading into the application. A copy of the payment receipt should be kept safely by the applicant.
- 8. For programmes of study that require work experience, a reference statement from the applicant's supervisor confirming the nature and length of the work experience should be scanned in readiness for uploading into the application. The applicant must have the required experience by the date of submission of the application.

- Normal Entry: Normal Entry means that an applicant is in possession of the requirements as stated in the intended programme of study, e.g. School Certificate, Certificate/Degree/Diploma Certificate, and/ or the required work experience in some cases.
- 10. Mature Age Entry (MAE): This is a special route reserved only for Botswana nationals who do not possess the normal entry qualifications. Applicants under this category are required to take appropriate MAE Examination. Undergraduate study programmes with this special entry route have this listed under their specific requirements.
- 11. Applicants, who applied for programmes with an interview or test as part of the selection process, are advised to enquire about the schedules for such if they do not receive any notification one month after the closing date.
- 12. Applicants will be notified of the dates of the selection interview(s) or test(s) they are required to attend and those who for whatever reason fail to attend a scheduled oral or written interview, will automatically be dropped from the selection list for that particular programme.
- 13. Applicants are also encouraged to always keep safe the information they receive during the application period and also through the acknowledgement notification they will receive from Undergraduate Admissions office.
- 14. Applicants with Disability: The University of Botswana welcomes applicants with disability, and considers their applications on academic merit like all other applicants. All applicants are expected to state whether they have any disability or not when they apply, so that the University's Disability Support Services Unit can contact them to appreciate the nature of their disability. The declaration of such information helps the

- University in assessing the learning needs of all applicants. Prospective applicants with disability may contact University's Disability Support Services Unit at: (+267) 355-2768/4990/4991/4183. University of Botswana will at all times preserve the confidentiality of student information.
- 15. Prospective applicants are expected to scan and save separately, preferably in pdf format, all the required documents in readiness for uploading during application:
- receipt for a fully paid Application Fee
- certified copy of the Omang for citizens
 ONLY or the Passport for other nationalities
- certified copy of the School certificate (or a certified copy of the Statement of Results for those still awaiting the issuance of their certificates), accompanied (if not in English) by a certified official English translation version.
- certified copies of additional official documents e.g.post-school certificate(s), transcript(s), professional registration certificate(s), certifying letters from Examining bodies, proof of change of name, etc where applicable.
- 16. The onus is on all applicants to ensure that

they upload all required documents with their application. Any application that does not have all the required documents will not be processed.


- 17. How to complete an Application Online:
 University of Botswana (UB) has an online application system that is intended to accord anyone seeking admission into UB study programmes to apply online provided they have an active email account. Prospective applicants are therefore expected to make their applications online through the "STUDY" link on the University of Botswana Website: www.ub.bw.
 Prospective applicants may use any Internet facility available to them to apply anytime of the day during the application period.
- 18. A guide, in the form of a booklet, on how to complete an application online, titled "ONLINE APPLICATION: A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE", is provided through the "STUDY" link.
- 19. Once you have submitted your application, an acknowledgement notification will be sent to you by email.
- 20. Selection Procedure: The Undergraduate Admissions office will review and process applications immediately after the closing date and applicants who are required to attend selection interviews or tests will be notified accordingly.

- 21. Applicants must ensure that they provide correct Email Address and Mobile number as these will be used to communicate any matter regarding their applications.
- 22. Change of Name/Surname: Applicants are to provide proof of change of name(s) if their Certificate(s) and/or other official documents show different names. THE UNIVERSITY ONLY ACCEPTS AN AFFIDAVIT FROM THE MINISTRY OF NATIONALITY, IMMIGRATION & GENDER AFFAIRS.
- 23. Applicants are encouraged to always request for the name of the UB staff attending them either telephonically or otherwise.

- a. The general minimum ENTRY requirements to the University shall be the Certificate IV, NCQF Level 4 such as Botswana General Certificate of Secondary Education (BGCSE) /equivalent qualification with at least six subjects NOT below a grade of E.
- b. For all programmes, English Language shall be one of the qualifying subjects.
- c. English Language must at least be a minimum of grade C for non-science degree programmes and at least a minimum of grade D for science-based programmes.
- d. For Bachelor's Degree programmes, at least five subjects shall be at a minimum of grade C obtained at one or two examination sittings.
- e. For Diploma and Certificate programmes, at least a minimum of three grades of C with a minimum of grade E in English Language shall be required. Five subjects may be considered if the minimum cut-off point based on six subjects is met.
- f. The minimum entry Certificate IV, NCQF Level 4 (BGCSE)/equivalent points shall be 34 points for all undergraduate Degree and 30 points for Diploma and Certificate programmes.
- g. The stipulated length of relevant work experience where required must have been met at the time of submitting the application.

- h. Any additional and/or special ENTRY requirements shall be specified under the programme offerings.
- i. Applicants shall be considered only for the study programmes they have selected.
- j. When applying for a programme which is offered by both full-time and distance learning mode, indicate whether the application is for full-time or distance learning, otherwise if not indicated it will be assumed the application is for a full-time programme.
- k. Meeting the minimum entry requirements does not guarantee admission. Admission will depend on availability of space and the competitive strength of each applicant's grades.
- I. Applicants may make changes to their programme choices. Such changes should be communicated in writing to the undergraduate admissions office.
- m. Applicants with Certificate IV, NCQF Level 4
 (BGCSE)/equivalent with a minimum of grade E in
 English Language may be considered for admission
 into Bachelors Degree programmes.
- n. Applicants may be considered through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) and Credit Accumulation and Transfer (CAT)



FULL-TIME PROGRAMMES

Note:

University of Botswana has observed that the Admission Cut Off Points for different study programmes average around both the Overall and Programme Points listed. The said averages are displayed as the Application Cut Off Points, which serve as a guide to prospective applicants as they select their study choices. Both the Overall and Programme Points listed are the minimum points that each prospective applicant has to satisfy in order to apply for their study choices.

Some programmes show Overall Points ONLY; while others show both the Overall and Programme Points. Admission into programmes with the Overall Points only is based on OVERALL POINTS ONLY, while admission into programmes with both the Overall and Programme Points is based on PROGRAMME POINTS, although they also have to meet the Overall Points.

Prospective applicants should note that these Application cut-off points are just a Guide, NOT THE FINAL ADMISSION CUT OFF POINTS, hence meeting them does not guarantee admission.

Applicants in possession of a recognized Diploma in Tourism and/or Hospitality Management may be considered for admission into this programme.

Applicants with a Diploma in Accounting and Business Studies or equivalent qualification may be considered for entry level 100 or 200 into any of the Degree programmes mentioned above.



Bachelor of Accountancy

Accountants are at the centre of business operations of all kinds. More specifically they work with business enterprises to develop business strategies; assist Board of Directors by implementing corporate controls; help investors by analysing company performance;

help the government to develop new measures to improve economic efficiency; work with all types of business enterprises to measure and communicate financial performance.

An accounting graduate can suitably work in any industry, commercial sector, service organization, financial sector, transport industry, public sector, government, education departments, agriculture, legal services, tourism, social services organization, accounting firms, counselling centres and even in defence.

The Bachelor of Commerce in Finance aims at providing quality graduates with skills in financial management. International finance, international monetary system, investment management, credit management, banking practice, marketing of financial services, credit risk management, actuarial analysis, corporate risk management, tax planning and insurance.

Bachelor of Business Administration (Marketing): Graduates can work in the following areas: Advertising; Customer Affairs; Brand and product management; Retailing Management; Purchasing and physical distribution; Sales management; Marketing Research; Marketing managers; Public Relations; Self-employment: Those interested in becoming professional or chartered marketers can take the qualifying examination of marketing professional associations such as the Institute of Marketing (UK), Marketing Federation of Southern Africa (RSA) and the American Marketing.

Bachelor of Business Administration (Management): Graduates of this programme can be employed in numerous professional positions available in different sectors of the economy such as project managers, management consultants, self employed entrepreneurs, operational managers / strategists, logistics and inventory managers, administrative officers, human resources managers, training and development officers, corporate management experts, organization and management analysts, planners and

development management experts and system analysts

Bachelor of Business Administration (Tourism & Hospitality Management): This program will definitely widen the students employment opportunities and upgrade management skills in the following areas: Hotels/Camp managers; Travel consultants/agents; Tour operators; Professional guide; Tourism officer; Wildlife conservation managers; Reservation officers; Finance officers for tourism and hospitality organisation; Tourism researchers/lecturers; Marketing managers; Tourism Planning/ Development; Events managers

Bachelor of Business Administration (Entrepreneurship and Enterprise Development Management): Graduates of this program will be able to conceptualize, initiate, establish and operate entrepreneurial ventures in any sector of the economy; Serve as trainers in entrepreneurship and enterprise development skills within Botswana's social structure; Provide leadership in the process of entrepreneurship and enterprise development; Serve as key sources of promoting corporate entrepreneurship in organizations they work for; Participate in economic policy drive as


entrepreneurship policy analysts, auditors, and evaluators.

Bachelor of Business Administration in International Business: Employment opportunities are available in multiple sectors of the economy: Botswana SMEs; Multinational corporations; inter-government organisations and NGO's; Government Departments and authorities with international involvement; Travel, tourism, and hospitality industry targeting foreign markets; International freight forwarding, shipping logistics and distribution firms; Telecommunications and internet-based businesses with global reach; Foreign diplomatic and trade representation in Botswana and SADC; Management consultancies, research agencies and industry associations etc.

Specific Entry Requirements:

Certificate IV, NCQF Level 4 (BGCSE)/equivalent with a minimum grade of C in English Language.

Applicants with Diploma in Primary/Secondary Education with a specialisation in art or its equivalent enter at Level 300.

Applicants with a Diploma in Visual Arts from recognised institutions enter at Level 300. Applicants with a Diploma in Primary/ Secondary Education with a non-art specialisation or its equivalent enter at Level 200.

Applicants with a Certificate in Visual Arts from recognised institutions enter at Level 200.

Applicants with a Teaching Certificate or its equivalent enter at Level 100.

Certificate IV, NCQF Level 4 (BGCSE)/equivalent with a minimum grade of D in English Language and a grade of C in Mathematics, grades of C in any two from Biology, Chemistry, Physics, or a minimum of grade BB in Science Double Award or equivalent, or a minimum of Grade A in Physical Science and a grade C in Biology, or equivalent.

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION IN BUSINESS EDUCATION

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:

Certificate IV, NCQF Level 4 (BGCSE)/equivalent with a minimum of grade C in English Language and Mathematics.

Applicants possessing an appropriate Diploma may enter at level 200 or 300 depending on the quality and number of credits obtained.

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (CHEMISTRY)

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:

Certificate IV, NCQF Level 4 (BGCSE)/equivalent with a minimum of grade D in English Language and a grade of C in Mathematics, and grades of C in any two from Bilogy, Chemistry, Physics, or a minimum of grade BB in Science Double Award or equivalent, or a minimum grade of A in Physical Science and a grade C in Biology, or equivalent.

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (COMPUTER SCIENCE)

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:

Certificate IV, NCQF Level 4 (BGCSE)/ equivalent with a minimum of grade D in English Language, grade C in Mathematics and grades of C in any two from Physics, Biology, Chemistry, Computer Studies, OR a minimum of grade BB in Science Double Award or a minimum of grade A in Physical Science and a grade C in Biology, or equivalent.

For entry into the programme at a higher level, applicants must have any one of the following:

- a. Transfer students from a Computer Science or equivalent programme from a higher institution considered equivalent to the University of Botswana
- b. Candidates holding a post-Secondary qualification, which is considered by the department as being at least equivalent to Level 100 of the programme and so deemed to earn the candidate an exemption from Level 100 of the programme
- c. Candidates holding a post-secondary qualification who do not meet criteria b above may be required to take some Level 100 courses.

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION IN COUNSELLING

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:

Certificate IV, NCQF Level 4 (BGCSE/equivalent

with a minimum of grade C in English Language.

Holders of a Certificate in Education or its equivalent plus BGCSE with at least three grades at a minimum of grade C shall enter at Level 100. Relevant work experience in counselling, or guidance and counselling shall be an added advantage.

Holders of a Certificate in Education or its equivalent who do not meet the requirements above but who have experience in counselling, or guidance and counselling shall be admitted into Level 100 of the programme. Applicants seeking admission through this route shall submit recommendation letters and proof of experience in counselling, or guidance and counselling.

Applicants with a Diploma or its equivalent in Adult Education, Home Economics, Nursing, Physical Health and Recreation, Primary Education or Secondary Education, Social Work or Theology, or any other relevant field shall be admitted into either Level 200 or Level 300 on the basis of accumulated credits in the area of Counsellor Education. Relevant work experience shall be an added advantage.

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT & EDUCATION)

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements

Certificate IV, NCQF Level 4 (BGCSE/equivalent with a minimum of grade C in English Language.

Applicants with a relevant Certificate shall enter at Level 100. Relevant work experience in an educational or child related setting shall be an added advantage.

Applicants with a relevant Diploma shall be admitted into Level 200 or 300 of the Degree Programme on the basis of accumulated credits in the area of education or child related setting. Relevant work experience in an educational or child related setting shall be an added advantage.

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION IN FAMILY AND CONSUMER SCIENCES

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements

Certificate IV, NCQF Level 4 (BGCSE)/equivalent with a minimum of Grade C in English Language, Grade D in Biology and/or Chemistry or related science combinations.

Applicants with a Diploma in Family and Consumer Sciences or Home Economics or a Diploma in Secondary Education from Colleges of Education or its equivalent shall be admitted into Level 200 or 300 of the Degree Programme on the basis of accumulated credits in the area of Family and Consumer Sciences or Home Economics.

Overall Points (Best 6 Subjects) **34**

BACHELOR OF EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements

Applicants with a Diploma in Educational Leadership and Management or equivalent shall enter at Level 300 of the degree programme.

Applicants with a Diploma in Education or its equivalent shall be admitted into either Level 200 or 300 of the Degree Programme on the basis of accumulated credits in the area of Educational Leadership and Management

or related areas. Relevant work experience in an educational setting shall be an added advantage.

Holders of a Teaching Certificate plus BGCSE will normally enter at level 100. Reference will be made to the articulation policy of the University of Botswana to determine the possibility of entering at other levels as appropriate.

Holders of a Teaching Certificate or its equivalent who do not meet the requirements above but have experience in an educational setting as managers will be admitted into level 100. Applicants seeking admission through this route shall submit recommendation letters and proof of experience in teaching and evidence of prior learning.

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (LIFELONG LEARNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT)

Duration (Years): 4 years

Specific Entry Requirements:

Certificate IV, NCQF Level 4 (BGCSE)/ equivalent with a minimum of grade C in English Language. Preference shall be given to applicants with some work experience in adult education, extension work and community development.

Applicants possessing a Diploma in Adult Education or related field will be considered for entry at Level 300. Preference shall be given to applicants with some work experience in adult education, extension work and community development.

Specific Entry Requirements:

Certificate IV, NCQF Level 4 (BGCSE)/equivalent with a minimum of grade D in English Language and a grade of C in Mathematics, and grades of C in any two from Biology, Chemistry, Physics, or a minimum of grade BB in Science Double Award or equivalent, or a minimum of grade A in Physical Science and a grade C in Biology, or equivalent.







Holders of a Bachelor's degree qualification with a minimum of Second Class Upper Division (2(i)) and had at least two sciences in the first year of the qualification are also eligible to apply.

Applicants into this programme will have to complete another application form which forms part of the selection process at the Faculty of Medicine. The form will be posted on the website beginning of April 2024.



Botswana has an acute need for medical practitioners, and this therefore places our graduates at a great advantage. Majority of doctors work in government clinics and hospitals but can also work in private clinics and hospitals and in academic institutions. However, many employment opportunities exist in other countries and international organizations including United Nations agencies (WHO, UNICEF, UNAIDS), the World Bank and regional organizations. Employment in other countries may require the fulfilment of specific licensing and registration regulations
